Computer Network & Systems (A.A.S.)

This program provides hands-on and theoretical knowledge of networking, digital communications, microprocessor systems, real-time software for control applications and electronics. Students will gain experience in Cisco Networking, and are required to complete the CCNA exam to graduate. Coursework includes lecture, laboratory exercises and class projects to help prepare students for the workforce.

Web Developer & Programming (A.A.S.)

This program is designed for students interested in gaining the skills needed for server-side web design. This program focuses on programming and scripting of websites for business and industry by providing hands-on experience in interfacing web applications with legacy applications.

Computer Technology (Certificate)

This program is designed for those who want to provide technical assistance for computer systems and users. Students will receive instruction in both business and technology, and can lead to industry certifications from CompTIA and Microsoft.

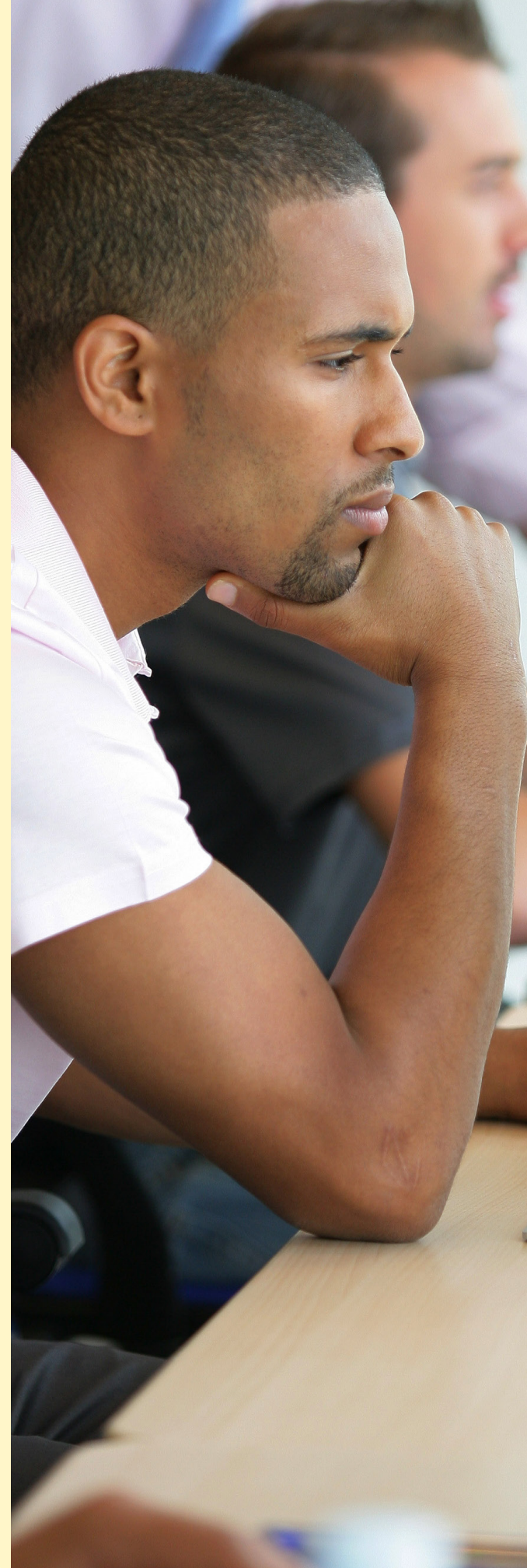

Digital Arts (A.A.S. and Certificate)

The **Digital Arts Associate of Applied Science** degree prepares students to work as commercial artists, or start their own businesses as freelance commercial artists. Students will gain real-world experiences creating scenes, photographing products and architecture, manipulating images in design software and branding. Students will also create a professional portfolio and business plan. The **Digital Arts Certificate** program prepares students to work as photographers, or to start their own businesses as freelance photographers. Students will gain real-world experiences creating scenes, photographing products and architecture, manipulating images in design software and branding. Students will also create a professional portfolio and business plan.
