## Office Administration (A.A.S.)

This program provides background and skills in general business, accounting and communication, as well as the use of computer productivity tools. Coursework includes application of basic accounting skills; business correspondence; software usage to create, edit and format documents, spreadsheets, databases and presentations; office organization; ethics; and more.

## Web Developer & Programming (A.A.S, Certificate and Job Training Program)

The associate degree and certificate programs are designed for students interested in gaining the skills needed for server-side web design. They focus on programming and scripting of websites for business and industry by providing hands-on experience in interfacing web applications with legacy applications. The job training program is designed to prepare students for entry-level jobs in web development and design.
