Industrial Technology Work Study Position – Greenville Campus

This position is responsible for cleaning and maintaining the lab areas of the Braman Family Education Center Building,
as directed by the Industrial Technology Lab Coordinator or the Industrial Technologies Department Chair.

The duties may include cleaning, minor maintenance and repairs on machinery and equipment in the Welding, CNC, and Machine shop. Other duties may be assigned.

The successful candidate should be detail oriented, a self-starter, have the ability to work without direct supervision,
and have some mechanical ability.

Up to 25 hours a week is available at \$13.37 / hour.

****Work-Study students must have a completed a 2025-26 financial aid file and be eligible for funding.**

Federal College Work Study (CWS): This program offers work, on or off campus, to students with financial need to help meet their educational expenses. Jobs are arranged after considering the amount of the award and the student's class schedule. Students are paid bi-weekly.

Please keep in mind if applying for work study, you must be eligible for federal funds. This means if your (SAP) Satisfactory Academic Progress is terminated you are not eligible to be a work study employee.
